“Torah” is 1103 undulating acres of quality grazing that has been extremely well managed for the past 70 years. Improvements include a substantial timber homestead, shearing shed and yards and excellent cattle handling facilities. The property has been used to turn off bullocks for the last 20 odd years with the property consistently handling over 600 at different stages of growth.

The country ranges from the lower lying flats against the Wando River and runs up a productive valley to the higher ranges above. Water is a feature of the property with the access to the river and an excellent catchment system along the creek line up to spring fed dams in the higher portions. Laneways run the length of the property back to the handling facilities with most fences being in excellent condition.

Feed has been well managed and maintained with over 170kg of fertiliser per annum spread over the property for the past 21 years and it really shows. Pastures are excellent with a variety of Phalaris, Cocksfoot and Clovers throughout.
